
Many drivers are unaware of the fact that it is not necessary to go to the DGT offices to process the permanent deregistration of a car with the *Dirección General de Tráfico*, as authorised scrapyards carry out this process electronically from their facilities.





REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

In order for our collaborating Authorised Treatment Facilities (ATF) to carry out the procedure for the **definitive deregistration of your vehicle at the DGT**, it is essential that you gather and provide the documentation detailed below.



You will be delivering

Photocopy of the holder's ID card on both sides, technical data sheet and vehicle registration certificate.

Vehicle is in the name of a company

DNI of the administrator and CIF of the company, electronic deregistration application and legal representation forms, technical data sheet and vehicle registration certificate.

The holder is a deceased person

DNI of the owner and of the heir who will hand over the vehicle, Responsible Declaration for the application for deregistration, death certificate and documentation of the car.

Other typical situations

If the holder is unable to make the delivery, he/she will need the Authorisation Form and, if he/she does not have the documentation, the Lost Form.
